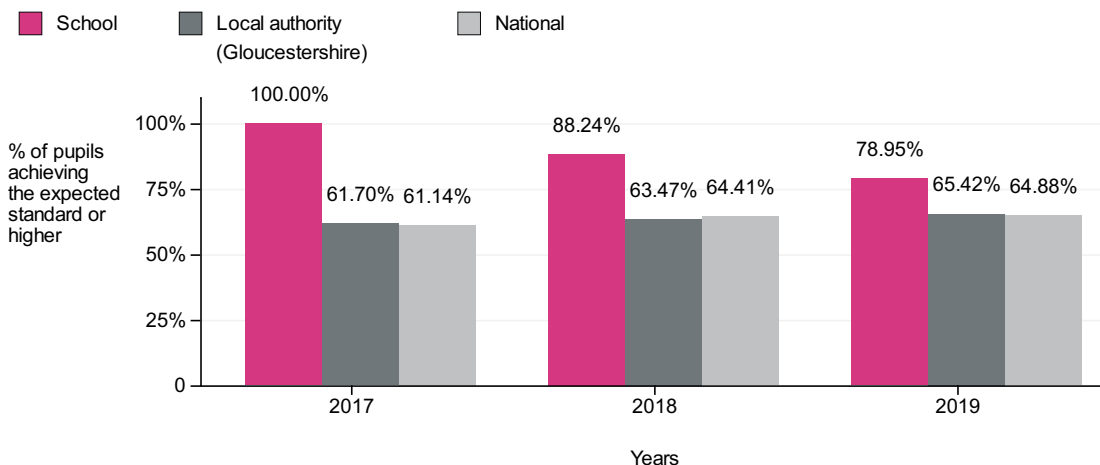

Number of pupils in 2019 = 19

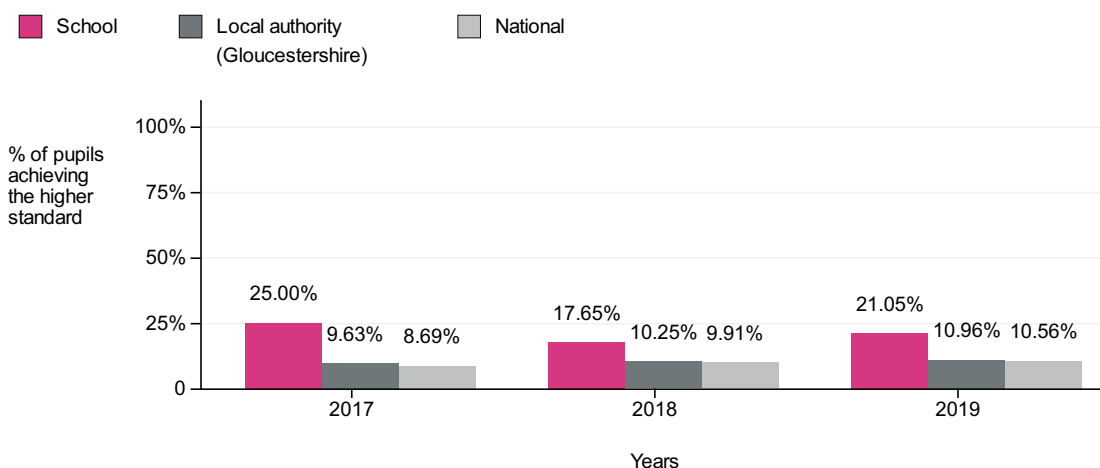


## Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

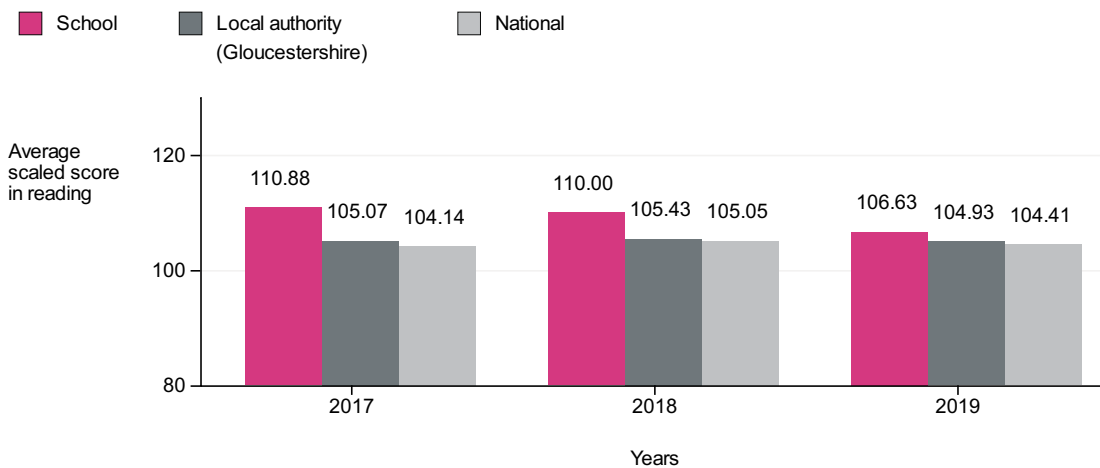
