



Ice Skating Trip



Dear Parents/carers

As part of our next theme 'Come Fly With Me,' we will be studying the Arctic Circle and looking at freezing and melting in Science. As part of the children's learning experience, we have arranged an ice-skating trip to **Imperial Gardens Ice Rink** in Cheltenham for Pathfinders Year 1 and Year 2 on the morning of **Monday 6th December**.

Children should arrive at school at normal time and we will leave at approximately 9.15. We will return to school for around 1pm meaning we will have missed hot dinners, so **all children should bring a packed lunch that day**.

Children should come to school wearing:

- Warm leggings/trousers.
- Trainers/warm socks
- Warm coat
- Gloves/hats

To make this visit possible, we are asking for a contribution of £9 per child. This will contribute towards the cost of the coach, skate hire, 45 minutes on the ice and a hot chocolate from the garden bar in Imperial Gardens. This payment can be made via School Spider where there is also a short form to let us know shoe size (to speed up getting skates on) and whether or not they would like an alternative to milk in their hot chocolate.

We can't wait to enjoy this trip with the children, hopefully they will be just as excited as we are!
