This term, Adventurers & Navigators have a local history & geography focus in their themes Out and About and Time Team. On Friday 13^{th} May we would like to take them on a local area tour. We will leave school by coach at 12.30 and be dropped at The Ham in Tewkesbury. We will then tour around the local area and be collected from Morrisons in time to return to school for normal collection at 3.15pm. We are asking for a contribution of £2 per child to help towards the cost of the coach, payable via Spider before the day of the visit. Children should wear school uniform with trainers.

They will experience keeper talks including birds of prey and elephants as well as enjoying the huge indoor & outdoor adventure playgrounds with their friends.
