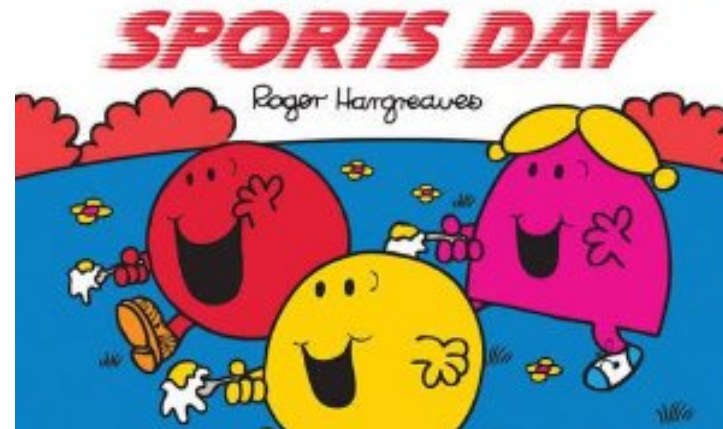

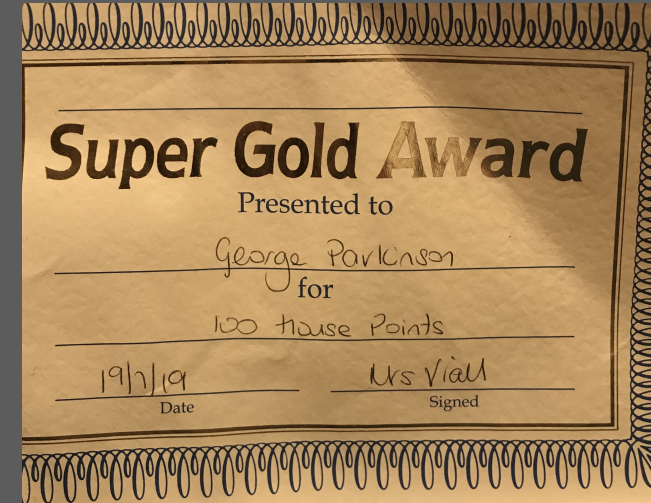

- I loved cadburys world, I was in Mrs Grants group with most of my good friends. I LOVE CHOCOLATE. I DID NOT SHARE IT EITHER



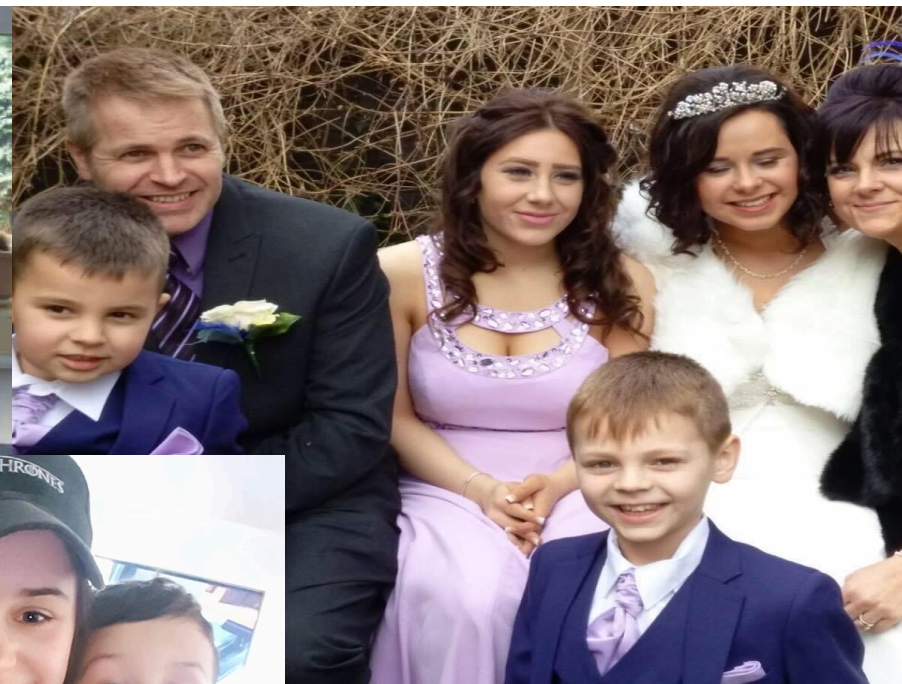
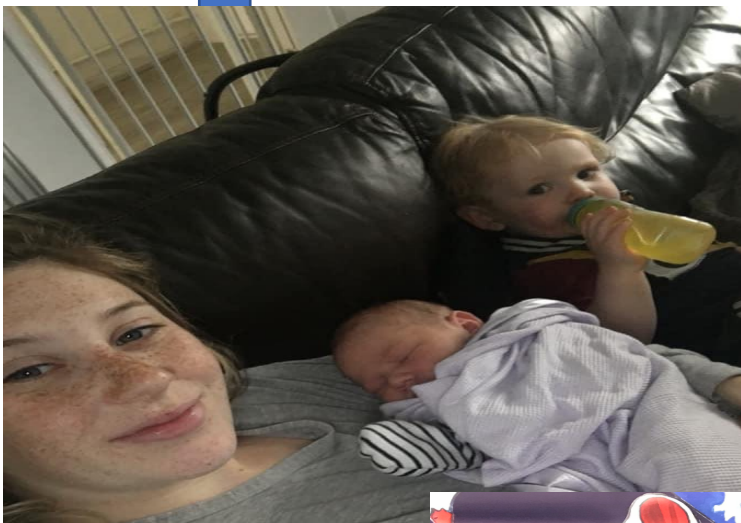
